Pollution Prevention - P2

Pollution prevention means:

- reducing or eliminating waste at the source
- promoting the use of non-toxic or less-toxic substances
- re-using or recycling materials rather than putting them into the waste stream.

Reducing waste at the source means lowering costs by increased efficiency in the use of raw materials, energy, water, or other resources and the protection of natural resources by conservation.

Energy Efficiency – E2

Energy efficiency means:

- identifying opportunities, including:
 - utility bill analysis; compressed air and HVAC efficiency
- setting energy performance goals
- planning and implementing energy management practices

KPPC follows the EPA's seven-step Energy Management Process, based on the **Energy Star Program**.
